From the Desk of Pastor Rob: "Summer Rest"

As the warmth of summer stretches across our days (hopefully not too hot!), many of us breathe a little easier. The calendar opens up, the sun lingers longer, and there's a quiet invitation in the air: *Slow down*. For those of us seeking to follow Jesus in a world of constant motion and endless striving, this invitation is not just a gift—it's a call to something radical.

In our culture, rest is often seen as unproductive or lazy. But from a progressive Christian perspective, choosing rest in a world that glorifies busyness can be an act of resistance. It is a reclaiming of our humanity and our worth beyond what we do, produce, or achieve. It is saying "no" to a system that too often leaves people burned out, disconnected, and spiritually dry.

Jesus frequently stepped away from the crowds—not to escape, but to reconnect with the Spirit, with creation, and with his own belovedness. Rest is not the opposite of action; it is what makes meaningful action possible. When we rest, we make space to listen—to the birds, to our bodies, to our neighbors, and to God. And often, that listening leads us toward compassion, justice, and hope.

Summer gives us an opportunity to live into this more generous rhythm. Whether

you find rest on a hiking trail, on your balcony with a book, in the laughter of a barbecue, or simply in silence, know that this time matters. You are not wasting time; you are grounding yourself in grace.

May this summer be more than just a break. May it be a reminder that you are deeply loved, exactly as you are—not because of what you accomplish, but because you belong. And from that grounded place, may we rise together, rested and ready, to build a world where all can find rest.

Grace and peace to us all as we continue to find our rest and center.
